This event is being held to assist citizens in shredding documents which might have confidential information on them. The shred event will be held at the La Grange Police Department located at 243 South College from 9 a.m. until 12 p.m. (Noon) on October 28th. Mobile, on-site paper shredding ensures that all discarded information is protected from unauthorized use, eliminating the possibility of fraud or identity theft. This is a free service to the customers of La Grange Utilities. Anyone bringing items to be shredded are asked to bring a City of La Grange utility bill with you in order to participate in this program.

Items accepted are paper, magazines, credit cards and documents with staples, binder clips or paperclips.

Items that will **NOT** be accepted are boxes, cardboard, floppy disks, hard drives, CD's, and USB drives
